My name is X and I would like to bring to your attention a hearing request that has been submitted by Energy and Commerce Committee members for H.R. 477, also known as Ally's Act. 350,000 children and adults are often overlooked and denied the right to hear because private insurers deny coverage for cochlear implants and bone anchored hearing systems, even when they are medically necessary! These hearing devices give people their lives back! They are often the only kind of hearing devices our community members can wear due to missing ears, no ear canals, sensorineural hearing loss, losing hearing to a tumor, head trauma, congenital hearing loss or drug ototoxicity from treating medical conditions such as cystic fibrosis. Cochlear implants and bone anchored hearing systems allow children and adults access to life changing treatment, so they can thrive in the community, participate in the workplace and enjoy a high quality of life. H.R. 477 would cost private insurers less than .30 cents per person/per year to cover the services under this bill, which is pennies! Please give our voices and Ally's Act, H.R. 477 the opportunity to be heard during a hearing this year!"
