## **Sample Email to Recruit Participation and Donations**

## Sample Post for Facebook

Once you send out your email and letter, you will want to send the message out on social media to everyone else. Below is suggested wording for a Facebook post. This can be modified for Twitter and other social media outlets. The most effective way to ensure your post is noticed is to send your message via video. If you cannot do a video message, enhance your post using photos.
